We hope that you are all having a lovely summer; we've even had the honor of seeing some of you during it! For those we have not seen, we look forward to seeing your smiling faces at *Nutcracker* tryouts and/or in the fall. There are several updates about the upcoming season that we would like to share with you.

- We are excited to have several new and returning additions to our faculty!
 - Shakurah Nuruddin- Returning faculty
 - We are respecting her wishes to refrain from sharing this information on social media & are asking you all to do the same; thank you!
 - Adriana Castellanet- Former Southold (& professional) dancer
- Also, after careful consideration, there will be new policies and a tuition increase during the upcoming 2023-24 season for the first time in over five years. This is a necessary adjustment to continue bringing education and instruction of the highest quality to our dancers; we thank you in advance for your understanding.
 - This year, we are requiring a credit card to be on file in your JackRabbit account
 - Tuition will be split up into eight (8) equal payments from September- April
 - Fees will be posted to your JackRabbit account by the last Friday of the preceding month
 - All payments will be processed on the first Monday of each month with your saved billing information
 - You may continue to pay by check if you prefer and our office will make a note on your account, but you must also have a credit card on file.
 - The new tuition fees are as follows:

Creative Dance 1 & 2: \$242.50 *By session

Primary Ballet 1 & 2: \$267.50 *By session

Ballet I: \$640 (\$85/mo.)

Ballet II: \$1,200 (\$155/mo.)

Ballet III: \$1,760 (\$225/mo.)

Ballet IV: \$2,380 (\$300/mo.)

Ballet V: \$2,970 (\$375/mo.)

Ballet VI, VII, VIII: \$3,120 (\$395/mo.)

*Non-Company: \$300/per month

***New policies further outlining the information above will be sent out in July.**

***Reminder: applications for tuition assistance are still available and due July 7th!**

***We will be resetting our Season starting next year; tuition assistance will only apply to Fall 2023 & Spring 2024!**
